My Dear Parishioners,

In today's gospel Jesus continues to speak reassuring words about love. He knows the unspoken questions in the hearts of His disciples – not only those around the Last Supper table, but all those of future generations. How will we be able to do what we heard Jesus tell us last Sunday: love one another as He loved us? "Whoever loves me will keep my word," says Jesus. Let us never forget this wonderful gift of peace and the Holy Spirit from Jesus. He will never abandon us.


