FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Parishioners,

The great season of Advent is full of rich symbolism, especially in regard to the contrast of light and darkness.

For example, Jesus is known as the "light of the world" and his birth was made known to the Magi by a bright star, as they recounted to King Herod, "For we have seen his star in the East and have come to worship him" (Matthew 2:2).

Stars then play a vital role in the symbolism of Christmas, pointing the way to Jesus Christ. The Virgin Mary is similarly known under such titles as "Star of the Sea," and is often referred to as a "star" that leads other people to her Son, the true "light" that shines in the darkness.

In Advent and throughout the Christmas season, the Church proposes an ancient hymn known by its Latin name, *Alma Redemptoris Mater*. It was written by St. Herman the Cripple in the 11th century and is recited after the conclusion of Night Prayer.

It is a beautiful prayer, one that highlights this symbolism and points our hearts towards Bethlehem, in eager anticipation of the birth of the Savior.

Below is the Latin and English translation of this beloved hymn, which can easily be turned into a prayer throughout the Advent and Christmas seasons.

Alma Redemptoris Mater, quae pervia caeliPorta manes, et stella maris, sucurre cadenti, Surgere qui curat populo: tu quae genuisti, Natura mirante, tuum sanctum Genitorem, Virgo prius ac posterius, Gabrielis ab oreSumens illud Ave, peccatorum miserere.

Loving mother of the Redeemer, gate of heaven, star of the sea, assist your people who have fallen yet strive to rise again, To the wonderment of nature you bore your Creator, yet remained a virgin after as before, you who received Gabriel's joyful greeting, have pity on us poor sinners.

The more we understand the rich traditions of the Church, the more we can grow in our understanding and in our faith.





"WHY, FATHER" by Fr. Emerson

Q: Father, what is Advent really about, and how does today's Gospel (Matthew 24:37–44) help us understand it? And what's the meaning behind the Advent wreath and its candle colors?

A: Advent is one of the oldest seasons of the Church—rooted as far back as the **4th century**—and it carries a beautiful **twofold meaning**.

First, we prepare for **Christ's first coming** at Bethlehem **&** .


Second, we prepare for **His second coming** as Judge and King ******.

That's why today's Gospel sounds so urgent. Jesus tells us to "stay awake," reminding us that His return will be sudden—just as unexpected as the flood in the days of Noah. But remember this: we don't speculate about the end times... we get our hearts ready. Advent calls us to confession, prayer, charity, and a renewed longing for Christ.

The **Advent wreath** expresses this beautifully. Though rooted in northern European Christian homes, the Church embraced it because of its rich symbolism:

- The **evergreen circle** shows God's eternal, unchanging love $\slashed{4}$.
- The **four candles** represent the four weeks of preparation.
- The **colors** teach us the spirit of the season:
 - Three purple candles for penance, preparation, and royalty—the color of kings and repentance.
 - One rose candle for Gaudete Sunday, the joyful midpoint reminding us that the Lord is near.
- The **increasing light** each week symbolizes Christ, the Light of the World, breaking into our darkness.

So Advent isn't just a countdown to Christmas—it's a **wake-up call for the soul**. The King who came in humility will come again in glory. Blessed are those who stay awake, ready, and eager for His return.
