DR. STEVEN SMITH (www.TheGodWhoSpeaks.com) is a sought-after speaker, author and Catholic theologian. He is currently Assistant Professor of Sacred Scripture at Mount St. Mary's Seminary in Emmitsburg, Maryland, the largest – and one of the most respected – graduate programs and houses of formation in the United States. Steve has a Ph.D. in New Testament from **Loyola University of Chicago**. As a FT seminary professor, he teaches on a wide array of biblical topics (OT, NT, etc.) including a course on Catholic Scripture study which inspired his first published book. In the Fall of 2012, Our Sunday

Visitor released Dr. Smith's book, *The Word of the Lord: 7 Essential Principles for Catholic Scripture Study*. It is endorsed by **Francis Cardinal George** among others. He and his wife Elizabeth (both re-verts to the Church) have been married 13 years. They have two lovely children and live in rural Maryland. Signed copies of his book – and major CD-sets of biblical teaching will be available at the event.
